OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL: 16th JULY

CARMEL AND LUDLOW: The order of Carmelites (Whitefriars) was founded by a group of hermits on Mount Carmel in Israel around 1150. After the crusades they moved west and established houses all over Europe. They arrived in Ludlow in 1350 and had a friary and large church at the bottom of Corve Street (where the present St Leonard's stands). A notable prior was Robert Mascall who became bishop of Hereford (and gives his name to the Mascall Centre). Whitefriars, opposite St Peter's, would seem to have been their land. In the 20th century a parishioner of St Peter's, John Fitzgerald, became a Carmelite priest and a distinguished Welsh poet and academic, with the bardic name of Ieuan Hir.

The central light in the East Window of St Peter's depicts Our Lady of Mount Carmel transferred from the earlier St Peter's.
